### The Corporal Works of Mercy

The Corporal Works of Mercy are found in the teaching of Jesus and give us a model for how we should treat all others, as if they were Christ in disguise. They are charitable actions by which we help our neighbors in the bodily needs.

### The Corporal Works of Mercy are:

- Feed the Hungry
- Give Drink to the Thirsty
- Shelter the Homeless
- Visit the Sick
- Visit the Prisoners
- Bury the Dead
- Clothe the Naked

### Requirements:

#### 4 DIFFERENT SERVICE EVENTS

- 2 service events done with Church of St. Ann
  - 1 one service event completed as an entire Confirmation community
    - Flea Market – Sat. Oct 28th
  - 1 one service event designed and completed with your Catechist and Confirmation class
- 1 service event – Completed by Individual
  - can be completed from St. Ann events or by personal choice outside of St. Ann
- 1 service event – Completed by Family
  - can be completed from St. Ann events or by personal choice outside of St. Ann

Service event opportunities offered through St. Ann's will be sent out monthly. Sign-ups will be done via Sign Up Genius. If you have a spring commitments, completing service events in the fall is suggested. Typically at least one service event is offered each month. If a service event is done outside of St. Ann it MUST be approved by the Director of Confirmation prior to completion in writing via email. Please consider whether an outside service event falls under the Matthew 25 guidelines before seeking approval. DO NOT complete a service event outside of St. Ann without prior approval as it may not count.
