



Celebrating the Sacrament of Marriage at the Church of Saint Ann

The parish community of Saint Ann is delighted to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage with you. The following guidelines are meant to assist you as you prepare for your marriage in the Church.

The first step is an initial meeting with Fr. Fontana (860-673-9858, ext. 231) at least 6 months prior to your wedding date. At that time he will go over the requirements of the Archdiocese of Hartford.

Sacramental and Legal Obligations

- Sacramental records: Baptism (must be dated within past 6 months), First Communion and Confirmation certificates. These documents should be obtained from the Parish in which these Sacraments were conferred.
- Pre-nuptial investigation must be completed with the priest.
- FOCCUS Inventory (pre-marital questionnaire) will be done with the Church of Saint Ann's Marriage Team.
- The couple are required by State Law to draw a Marriage License from the town where the marriage is to take place. The license may be drawn 65 days prior to the date of the marriage.

Church Donations and Fees

**Parish Donation: \$500 for registered parishioners
\$800 for non-parishioners**

All fees are to be paid prior to your ceremony or on the occasion of your wedding rehearsal.

Organist and soloist fees are to be paid separately.

Music

Prior to your ceremony you are requested to meet with our Music Director, Mercedes Featherston (860-836-3886), who will help you plan the appropriate music for your wedding ceremony. She can also assist you if are interested in any additional instrumentation.

Flowers and Decorations

If you would like help or advice with floral arrangements for the church, or would like general protocol regarding wedding flowers at St. Ann, please call Janet Fischer at 860-989-6045.

Throwing rice, confetti or any other material that may pose a slip/trip hazard are expressly forbidden, as is the strewing of flower petals, real or artificial, on the floor. Decorations may be attached to the pews, but tape may not be used. Please arrange for someone to remove the decorations after the wedding. The church does not own a white runner/carpet. These can be bought at a store such as Michaels.
